2. Grants – Tucker
 - a. 11 million to distribute
 - b. FFCA –Decontamination Kits for all apparatus in State
 - c. 555 departments to receive survey for kits / check for link and ensure you have filed
 - d. Training Kits for training centers... left over kits could show up
3. Legislative
 - a. Language to clean up Special Chief (5 bugles only) /anyone else must go through process
 - b. Rolls & Responsibilities, making it 1 year time frame to complete process.
4. State notified on felony conviction of FF automatically (Mary Ann Benson)
 - a. Exempted letter from State being sent
